Get to Know the Tarheel Quilters: Sunshine Chair - Barbara Jackson

- 1) How long have you been a member of the Guild? *I originally joined in 1987, but didn't renew after the first year. I've been a consistent member since the early 1990's.*
- 2) How long have you been quilting? *For 30 or 40 years. I was first exposed to quilting when I was 5 or 6 years old and I attended quilting bees with my grandma...I would thread needles for the ladies and sometimes they would let me quilt along the edge of whatever they were working on. It wasn't until I was older that I realized allowing me to quilt only along the edge made it easier for the ladies to remove my inexpert quilting stitches later.*
- 3) What type of sewing machine do you have? Or if you have multiple machines, which one do you prefer/use the most? *I have 7 machines, but the one I use the most is my Elna Quilter's Dream 7300. I also cherish my grandmother's treadle machine that she bought in 1929...I even have all of the owner's manuals and the original receipt.*
- 4) What is your favorite quilt that you've made OR what is the quilt you're proudest of (provide a brief description)? *My favorites are my "Summertime" appliqué quilt which took "First Place" and "Best in Show" ribbons at the NC State Fair and an appliqué wall hanging that hangs above my bed. The wall hanging is approximately 64" by 70" and has four large hand appliquéd flower blocks with a border designed by Dee Dalton.*
- 5) What is your favorite quilting trick or shortcut you've learned OR favorite quilting tool you can't live without? *I try to find an easy way to make any block; for example I have a technique to make a 9-patch square with just four seams. When doing hand appliqué, I always use straw needles.*
- 6) What project are you currently working on OR how many different projects are you in the middle of? *I have 7 quilt tops in progress. I am always working to finish UFOs (while creating more UFOs along the way).*
- 7) I love to...*pass on my knowledge about quilting.*

Background - white

4 - 4 1/2" squares

4 - 2 1/2" squares

4 - 3" squares - DRAW A LINE DIAGONAL ON BACK

Yellow -

4 - 3" squares

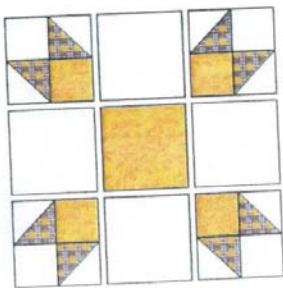
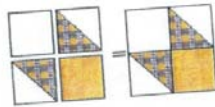
Any Color You Want

1 - 4 1/2" square

4 - 2 1/2" squares

Place a 3" background square on a yellow 3" square right sides together - stitch on each side of drawn line - cut apart on drawn line - Press seam to yellow - Square up to 2 1/2" MAKE 8

Sew a white 2 1/2" square to a half square 2 1/2" square
Sew a half square 2 1/2" square block to a colored 2 1/2" block
MAKE 4



← LAY OUT BLOCKS LIKE THIS
Sew Blocks into Rows
Sew Rows into the Block
