We have 28 girls, only 5 boys and 25 sets of multiples, mostly girls there also, in quilts stored. THINK BOYS, PLEASE.

Since I'll be on vacation and probably not back in time for the next meeting, our trip to the NICU in July will be a week later than normal. We'll deliver baby quilts to the NICU on July 26, leaving the lobby at 9:30 a.m.

If you want to make a Fat Quarter bag at the July 16th Sew Day, you'll need:

6 coordinating fat quarters

2 1/8 yards of 42" wide fabric for lining and handles

1/4 yard of flannel for handles (flannel will be inside the handles, so doesn't need to match)

22" of 1"-wide non-roll elastic (Nancy will have some extra available)



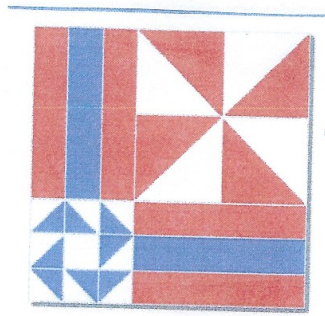

Two - 4 3/4 BLOCKS RED
 Two - 2 X 16 STRIP - Red
 Four - 2 1/2 BLOCKS BLUE
 One - 2X16 STRIP Blue
 Two - 4 3/4 BLOCKS WHITE
 Four - 2 1/2 BLOCKS

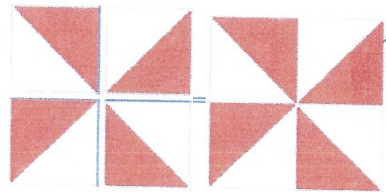
DRAW A DIAGONAL LINE ON BACK OF WHITE 4 3/4 BLOCKS AND THE 2 1/2 BLOCKS

WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER PUT WHITE 4 3/4 BLOCK AND RED 4 3/4 BLOCKS TOGETHER. STITCH A SCANT 1/4 ON BOTH SIDES OF DIAGONAL LINE .

CUT APART. PRESS TO DARKER COLOR.

4- RED, WHITE, HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

SEW TOGETHER TO MAKE A PINWHEEL BLOCK



WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER PUT WHITE 2 1/2 BLOCKS ON BLUE 2 1/2 BLOCKS

STITCH A SCANT 1/4 ON EACH SIDE OF DIAGONAL LINE

CUT APART AND PRESS TO BLUE. TRIM TO 2" MAKES 8 HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE. SEW BLUE, WHITE HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES IN 3 ROWS ACCORDING TO THIS LAYOUT. USE 2" WHITE BLOCK IN MIDDLE



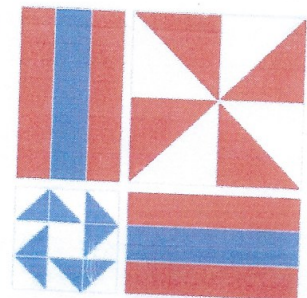
SEW RED AND BLUE 2X16 STRIPS TOGETHER WITH BLUE IN MIDDLE. PRESS SEAMS TO BLUE FABRIC

CUT IN HALF FOR 2 SECTIONS 5X8

LAY OUT ALL PIECES LIKE THIS:

SEW 2 HORIZONTAL ROWS. PRESS SEAMS IN EACH ROW TO THE LONG STRIP SCANT

JOIN THESE TWO ROWS AND YOU ARE FINISHED.
