Block of the Month (BOM) Returns!

After taking a break from the BOM during 2021, we will be starting again in January. This year we will be making 10” blocks. The pattern will specify the color and type of fabrics to use. The pattern for the first block will be available at the January meeting and will also be published in the next newsletter for those unable to attend the meeting. If you are new to the Tarheel Quilters’ Guild, this is how the program works - bring your completed block(s) to the next meeting and enter your name in the drawing. (if you bring two blocks, enter your name twice). There will be a drawing and the winner will receive all of the blocks entered. You might consider making an additional block each month in the color of your choice to keep so that even if you don’t win a set of blocks, you will have enough blocks for a sampler quilt at the end of the year. Please remember that some lucky quilter is going to take your block home to make a quilt, so follow the color instructions, check the size of your completed books and try to do you best work.

Tarheel Quilters Guild December 2021 Minutes

The meeting was held December 19th at Westminster Presbyterian Church. Minutes from the November 2021 minutes were in the newsletter and were approved. A festive holiday spread was provided by the Guild with food from Publix and centerpieces of poinsettias which were later given to Guild members.

Treasurer's report indicated \$11,272.55 in the account. Additional funding will come from ads and final raffle ticket sales.

Marlene gave the Baby Quilts update. Marlene received 8 quilts last month and had 152 stockings on hand to deliver to NICU. She delivered 21 quilts last month. Marlene advised she has 17 boy, 4 girl, 2 boy twin sets, 2 girl twin sets, 2 boy/girl twin sets and 2 triplet sets on hand. All baby quilts are needed at this time to replenish the on-hand stock. From December 2020 to November 2021 166 quilts were received.

VA quilts reported 124 quilts on hand. These are to be delivered to VA Hospital in February 2022. Will need VA quilts to replace those delivered at that time. VA quilts are to be 45" by 45" and can be in any colorway (not just red/white/blue).

Karen Potts presented awards, scholarships and service pins. Congratulations to all those who received recognition for their work. New points sheets are available. 45 points minimum are required for submission in November 2022.

Cindy announced that 11 remembrance renewals had been completed so far and 1 visitor joined the Guild. Even if you receive a free membership, a membership form must be completed in order to remain on the roster. See Cindy if you have any questions.

Installation of new board members was completed. Welcome to our new board!

Members participated in a holiday gift exchange. Door prizes were awarded and Fat Quarter of the Month was drawn.

2021 Quilt Raffle ticket was drawn. Debby Grice left a voicemail for the winner.
