General Meeting Minutes (October 16, 2022)

- The meeting was brought to order at 2 pm by 2VP Colleen Heacock. Nancy is participating in a Walk for Downs Syndrome today. Colleen asked that we please wear our nametags so we know who everyone is and that we could have a possible workshop for making nametags.
- General meeting notes from September were approved as posted in the newsletter.
- Treasurer's report as of October 1, 2022 presented by Karen Pott. Rhonda is home recovering from getting both hips replaced. She is doing well, and we can send cards. There was an expense for batting for the baby and VA quilts – it was at least \$399 + tax - \$427. Everything is going up.
- Nominating committee – Amy reported that Carolyn Edwards, Barbara Munoz, and she made calls to the guild members for board offices and committee chairs, namely the President and Baby chair positions. Nancy Moore has been President for 2 years, and Colleen has also been 2 VP for 2 years. Amy reported that Barbara Munoz was interested in running for President, Naomi Bonilla as 1VP, Debby Grice as 2VP for programs, Amy for Secretary, and Rhonda for Treasurer. Parliamentary and Scholarship is open. Karen Potts has a list of committee chairs to be filled.
- Karen Potts reminded members to fill out a ballot for the Kay Bryant Scholarship that gives a deserving member a free membership for next year. Members not eligible are current board members.
- 1VP Naomi reported that there are 15 members signed up and paid for the upcoming workshop with Aby Dolinger on Oct 22 at the North Regional library.
- 2VP Colleen talked about the December meeting using a gift bag approx. 8x10 for the exchange gift program. There is a \$15 limit – be creative with fabric, notions, a handmade gift (ie pincushion) and goodies.
- Program: 3 corners – Quick gifts to make for the holidays! Karen Potts demonstrated a folded Danish star ornament, Colleen Heacock demonstrated a snowman ornament and a quick gripper pad to make. Ashley Ledford demonstrated her gift card holder.

- There were 44 signed in today – 5 guests! We now have 78 members.
- Door Prizes were given out.
- Marlene talked about being the Baby Chair – there were 16 quilts turned in last month. She went to the hospital on September 27 and gave out 8 boys, 8 girls and one set of twins for 18 quilts. She would like to go on Tuesday this week after the Sunday guild meeting. She has 62 stockings on hand. Pam Gahan and Donna Lazar volunteered to be the Baby Chairs for next year. They will get with Marlene to see the NICU and how our delivery system works. Thank you for volunteering!!
- Colleen reported that there are approx. 300 placemats on hand now.
- Sunshine – Charlotte sent Rhonda Gooding flowers for her recent surgery. Karen Graham is having a difficult recovery from hip surgery. The guild will send a donation to a charity for Mary Larsen (guild member who recently passed) and was Donna Saunder's mother. Please remember her with cards.
- VA Quilts – Judy reported having 76 quilts on hand.
- Challenges – Debby reminded members that the Patriotic Panel challenge is due in November
- Newsletter – please have your notes in to Ashley by October 27.
- Raffle tickets – please get in touch with Mandy if you need more tickets to sell. Karen Potts took ticket monies at the meeting today.
- Show and Tell – Wow, what beautiful work! Sandy Russell showed her labor of love – a quilt showing her family from her childhood days, hand appliqued and quilted with pictures of her family. Many of us would love to have a class on hand applique with Sandy. Sabrina Thompson showed a Farm Girl quilt that will be raffled for a Boys and Girls club. Thank you to all who showed your work!

Tarheel Quilters' Guild Block of the Month October 2022 - Whirling Star

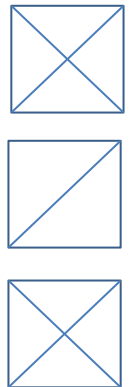


Fabric Requirements:

Background fabric of black solid and two bright colors

Cutting Instructions:

- | | |
|----------------|---|
| Black | Cut 1 square at 5 ¼" and cut twice on the diagonal
Cut 1 square at 2 ½"
Cut 4 rectangles 4 ½" by 2 ½" |
| Color 1 | Cut 2 squares at 4 7/8" and cut once on the diagonal
(shown in pink in the diagram) |
| Color 2 | Cut 1 square at 5 ¼" and cut twice on the diagonal
(shown in green in the diagram) |

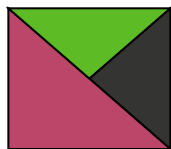


Assembly:

Step 1: Sew the Color 2 triangles to the background triangles along one side, Press to the background fabric.

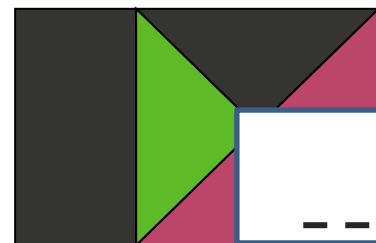


Step 2: Sew the Step 1 triangles to the Color 1 triangles; press to the larger triangle. This QST should measure 4 ½".



Step 3: Sew the square from Step 2 to the right edge of the background rectangle; press to the rectangle. Make 4 units

Step 4: Sew the rectangle from Step 2 to the center background square right sides together (RST) with a partial seam shown by the dashed line; the seam should be approximately 1" in length). Finger press the partial seam to the center.



Step 5: Continue sewing the rectangular blocks to the center adding them in a clockwise direction. After sewing the last rectangle to the center, you can finish stitching the partial seam to complete the block. Press all seams to the center.

This is a 10" block (10 ½" unfinished)
