The Guild participated in 3 corners at our October meeting, focusing on binding, labels and hanging sleeves.

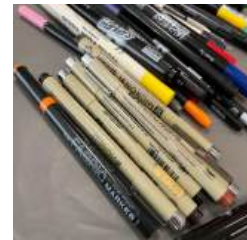
If you have ever been interesting in flange binding, AnnMarie & Sally showed us how using 1.5" binding and 1.75" flange fabric folded even and then sewn to the the front.

Sabrina talked about different types of labels and pens to use to



make quilt labels. Don't forget to include the maker, year and quilt pattern!

Thanks to Bonnie for showing us how to add sleeves for hanging to our quilt backs.



Sleeves can be permanently sewn into the binding or added temporarily for a show.

Baby Quilts

This month baby quilts were given for 14 boys, 15 girls, 1 set of boy twins and 2 sets of boy/girl twins to the Cape Fear Valley Hospital NICU. The NICU is still in need of “memory quilts” which are small (around 12”) single block quilts that are backed but made without batting for babies who did not survive. These mini quilts are gifted to the parent in lieu of a quilt in the memory box supplied by the hospital. This is a simple way to utilize orphan blocks, test your skills without committing to a large project and an additional way to contribute to this worthy philanthropy. Recipe Corner

Bisquick Sausage Muffins

16 ounce breakfast sausage - I use Jimmy Dean country mild

4 large eggs - lightly beaten

1 cup sharp cheddar cheese - shredded

1 cup Bisquick Original Pancake & baking mix

- preheated oven to 350 degrees. line 12 cup muffin pan with cupcake liners or instead grease the muffin tin well set aside I use Pam cooking spray works well

- In a skillet over medium - high heat cook and crumble the sausage (16 ounces) until no pink color remains. remove to a paper towel lined plate cool sausage for about 10 minutes

- in a medium mixing bowl stir together eggs shredded cheese cooked sausage and baking mix. stir until thoroughly combined

- fill each muffin tin 3/4 full. bake in preheated oven until the tops of the muffins are golden brown and are baked through about 20 minutes

The rules are: “Make a VA quilt. Your quilt must meet the standard requirements for a VA quilt (45” x 45”). Please do not make a flag. Show us your idea of America: i.e. a playground, a snow capped mountain, a church or a beach. Quilter’s name on the label should be covered with painter’s tape or filled in after the challenge prizes are awarded.” In answer to a question that was asked, it is okay if there is a flag in a fabric print or as part of a panel – your quilt cannot be a reproduction of a flag.

*Debbie Grice will be running the challenge in November. Please place any quilts to be entered on the stage upon arrival. Debbie will take care of numbering the entries.
