Baby Quilts

This month quilts for 10 boys, 7 girls, 2 sets of boy twins and 1 set of boy/girl twins were delivered to the NICU.

The NICU is in need of “memory quilts” which are small (around 12”) single block quilts that are backed but made without batting for babies who did not survive. These mini quilts are gifted to the parent in lieu of a quilt in the memory box supplied by the hospital. This is a simple way to utilize orphan blocks, test your skills without committing to a large project and an additional way to contribute to this worthy philanthropy. GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MINUTES - SUNDAY, AUGUST 18, 2024

- Debbie Pederson, in absence of Barbara Munoz, opened the meeting on time, 2:00 PM She graciously thanked the sponsors for the Saturday Sew Day held at the Chemours Facility.
- The next sew day will be the 1st Saturday in September, September 7. The theme will be Christmas Stockings workshop at the Chemours/Dupont facility. Look for the **DERC** sign. Bring your own fabrics and some battings, if adding to your stockings. Patterns will be provided as well as some batting.
- New officers for 2025 will be installed during the December membership meeting. At the September board meeting, present board members will be asked if they are interested in continuing to the next year. Nominations will be presented to the general membership meeting in November for voting. The new slate of officers will be installed in the December membership meeting.
- We had 56 members at our August meeting. 4 guests were warmly welcomed. Our membership total is 87!
- The Treasurer reported balances.
- The next Quilt Fest Meeting will be September 12, 5:45-6:45 PM at the N. Regional library at corner of Rosehill & McArthur Road. Bonnie McPhail will be our Treasurer for the Quilt Fest.
- Cumberland Community Foundation awarded our guild \$1,200 toward service projects. Our guild will be included in our Giving Tuesdays brochure & website. When the endowment is received, the guild needs to establish the source for these funds. The Quilt Fest will have the boutique for handmade gifts to be sold. Part of the prices will go to the guild and rest to the contributors.
- Nancy Moore was our program for August. She presented a fantastic array of her quilts she has made over the years. "Thank you, Nancy, for a beautiful display of your beautiful quilts".
- Next Saturday, August 24th, Aby Dollinger will host the workshop for her Ribbon Star Quilt. This will be at the gym at the rear of Nancy's church, 121 Lofton Street.
- Other workshops include Sonya's class, March 1st 2025; Debbie Henry class (12 Maximum); Ann Carr will offer a workshop Summer 2025; and Annette Ornelas (Southwind Inspirations) will have a workshop at time to be scheduled.
- Colleen asked all who have volunteered to assist her with the Ribbons for Quilt Show to see her before leaving today.
- VA reported 7 quilts turned in, making 55 total on hand. Another class/sew day is planned for November, 2024. Need MORE quilts.
- Baby Quilts given this month. 6 Girls, 6 Boys, 1 set Boy Twins and 1 set of Boy/Girl Twins. Also, reminded members that we need the Memory Quilts for those who have lost their babies at or before birth. These items should NOT include batting and be no more than 12X12 square inch in size. Good source for orphan blocks, etc.
- Guild members reminded VA quilts maximum should be 50X50", baby quilts max should be no larger than 40X40", prefer 36X36 Lori. our VA Chair has batting .
- Charlene advised has 77 placemats at last meeting. We turned in 240 last year. (10 placemats equal 1 space on Guild "Bingo Card")
- Marlene is Christmas Stockings chair and ready to receive your handiwork.
- Charlotte passed out Birthday gifts to our members & door prizes
- Cindy Clifton was our FQ winner and our Block of Month winner of 11 blocks.
- Debbie P gave fabric needed for Jelly Roll workshop. 2 1/2-3 yards background and strips of your choice.
- Enjoyed great display of UFO's.
- Reminded membership that each block of Bingo Card must be signed by chairperson or board member when submitted.
- Reminder: Bring in non-perishable food items for the Church donations
- Turn in items for Fest Boutique to Ashley Ledford.
- Reminded members to visit "M&M Quilting" on Facebook for Boutique inspirations.
- Meeting closed at 3:34 PM by Debbie Pederson.
